walls, working as observation decks for the building's history and present.

The new rooftop was created by renovating the 19th century pavilion, and by adding a new steel and glass floor which hovers above the central courtyard; the latter is a precise insert of a modern structure – an orthogonal grid of Miesian memory – carefully detached in space and time from the historical arches.

After meandering through the intricate spaces of the Fondaco, the pavilion reconnects one with the Venetian sky – filtered by the web of steel beams, bolts and joints of its structure – and like a crescendo, it leads to a large new terrace above the Venetian landscape, both a device for touristic voyeurism and the final stage of an urban and transformative experience, from the dark passages of the historical city, through the excavated spaces of the Fondaco, to a rare and expansive panorama...

From a mute, hermetic icon of a past mercantile era to a porous urban system marked by the inevitable flows of global tourism, the Fondaco has unveiled its secret brutality, offering through its windows and terraces a privileged point of view for the understanding (and consumption) of Venice.

* * *

Our project did not reach its maximum potential. The change in tenant through the process has questioned not only the original architectural project, but also its mission for the city. While the presence of shopping in historical centers seems to be an inevitable condition, the real question for us today is to investigate an alternative model of retail: one more specific to its context, open and diversified, curated and less invasive. This would have required a level of experimentation and courage that the dogmas of the luxury system do not allow for.

The intervention we have realized – modified, adjusted, adapted multiple times from its original intentions – has been overwritten by a series of "extravagant" installations, a thick layer of contemporary yet nostalgic retail paraphernalia, supposedly at the service of rich tourists' imagination. It will be necessary to look past this layer if one is to grasp and read our design intentions.


The Fondaco dei Tedeschi, formerly a trading post for German merchants, then a customs house, now stands as a muted icon of the Venetian mercantile era. First constructed in 1228. twice destroyed by fire and rebuilt (in its current form in 1506), then subject to a series of major architectural interventions to accommodate new uses (towers removed, courtyard covered with glass, structure rebuilt again...), the Fondaco has constantly reshaped itself; its preservation is a history of change. The current role as a post office has diminished in tandem with the native population of Venice, leaving the bulk of the building unused for the first time in centuries. The latest evolution of the Fondaco will create a thriving contemporary trading post in the form of a modern department store. The courtyard and the renovated rooftop will be used for events, art, and cinema, reactivating the historic Venetian connection between culture and commerce.

The Fondaco dei Tedeschi has been rebuilt completely on two occasions, with its current configuration dating from 1506. Since then, the building has undergone many radical transformations to accommodate new uses: its towers removed, courtyard covered with glass, structure rebuilt, façade restored, and new windows added, among many other interventions. For the Fondaco, preservation is a history of change.

OMA has designed a range of architectural modifications and developed a cultural program to reactivate the building as a vital public space, from top to bottom. A terrace with rare views of the Grand Canal will be created by removing two sides of the existing roof, leaving the building's profile intact while unlocking exciting potential for the Fondaco dei Tedeschi as a major destination and vantage point for tourists and Venetians alike. The rooftop, together with the courtyard below, will become a public venue for cultural events including exhibitions and film screenings. A year-round cultural program will be aimed at locals and tourists – the 20 million who visit the city each year, as well as the 900,000 who come specifically for the Biennales and festivals. The new Fondaco dei Tedeschi, as a department store and public event space, aims to reestablish the historic Venetian connection between culture and commerce.


New entrances to the building will be created from the Campo San Bartolomeo and the Rialto to encourage circulation, escalators will be added to create a new public route through the building, rooms will be consolidated in a way that respects the Fondaco's structure, while crucial historic elements like the corner rooms will remain untouched. Historic aspects of the building, lost for centuries, will be resurrected: the walls of the gallerias will once again become a surface for frescoes, reappearing in a contemporary form.


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
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


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


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





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



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
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

















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















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
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





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





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
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


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


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
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
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
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


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


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










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
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


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


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
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





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
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


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





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


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
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




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


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
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




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
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
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
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
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
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


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
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
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
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


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VENICE POTENTIAL STRATEGY FOR A CONDENSER

The most successful department stores become the true expression of their location. They value, above all else, the city in which they are situated. Great cities have great department stores and the two are intricately linked, working symbiotically to great effect. The department store's currency is not just money, perhaps more important to their long term success is their cultural currency with the local inhabitants and visitors to their city, whether it be London, Paris, New York or indeed Venice.

Venice provides the perfect environment for a department store to operate, being the iconic city that it is, both culturally and socially. It is a world-class international tourist destination while successfully preserving and promoting uniquely local architecture, art, design, cuisine, language and geographic environment. Venetians like with centuries of extraordinarily rich cultural expression all around them but, as a great city should, also ensure their place in contemporary culture with annual festivals of architecture, art and film.

The architecture and art biennales, the Film Festival and other traditional events such as Carnevale and the regattas provide endless inspirational material to create authentic links between the city and the calendar and contents of the reatail business. The Fondaco will be an open and adaptable cultural canvas for Venice throughout the year.

The prestigious location and architecture of the Fondaco del Tedeschi building will facilitate associations and connections with the principal local institutions and events of the city. The original function of this building has a history of commercial trading, as the market for Germanic merchants, operating as a type of Arabic inspired souk from the 13th century through to the Napoleonic era.

The classic Cinquecento architecture of the Fondaco dei Tedeschi, with its numerous windows, The classic Cinquecento acrintecture of the Fondaco del Fedesoni, with its numerous windows, open courtyard, distinctive façade and terraces, entrances and wallways, provides an ideal build-ing and malleable carvas for public access, art and design installations and the theatrical perform-ances that naturally make up a department store is fabric. The unique opportunity of creating a department store at the Fondaco del Tedeschi will be the chance to represent the 'best of Venice', in as dynamic and inspirational way.

Our ambition for the Fondaco del Tedeschi is to regenerate it into a unique public facility for Venice and its visitors. Commercial activities will overlap to an autonomous cultural offering that will add to the already rich scene of the city.

Drafting the strategy for cultural master plan raises the issue of how to integrate a new kind of cultural program within a city context already oversaturated by art venues, museums and foundations, without replicating existing models.

It is possible to observe a striking disparity between the number of visitors to Venice each year and the number of visitors attending key cultural events of the city, such as the Biennale (art, architec-ture, dance, cinema and theatre). To be exact, the proportion is 20 million verses 0.9 million. The rich cultural calendar of Venice seems to appeal only to an intellectual minority of visitors.

In response to this condition we envision a Sessonal Curatorial Strategy.

A diverse selection of individuals and collectives will be invited to design the program of events at the Fondaco: Sesson after season, politicians, graphic designers, hackers, environmentalists, film makers, journalists, tologers... will courte according to their unique expertise.

The outcome will be an edectic regeneration of activities, enticing a range of interests and tastes.

Alongside the invited curators, we propose an annual anonymous competition of ideas open to any individual or collective inspired to participate. The winning curator/s will orchestrate a program of events, transforming the Fondaco into a vital support and ideal stage to showcase unknown talents.

Developing an encompassing synergy between the Seasonal Curatorial Strategy and parallel cultural events of the city of Venice will also be essential in crafting the identity of the Fondaco as a critical element of the city's cultural infrastructure. This synchronicity will contextualise and validate the Seasonal Curatorial Strategy.

The Fondaco will be a CONDENSER for different people, ideas and events. Its potential will manifest in its chameleon regeneration of offerings, appealing to a wide spectrum of citizens and of visitors to Venice.

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
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
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
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










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










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


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










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








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


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
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
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
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
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


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


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
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
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
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









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


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









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


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
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



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




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
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
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
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



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
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


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
